**Objective:**

- The World Environment Day celebration was organized to raise awareness about the importance of environmental conservation and sustainable living. By combining both outdoor and creative activities, the event sought to foster environmental consciousness among students while also engaging them in practical action and artistic expression.

**Activity Details:**

- The celebration began with a tree plantation drive held at a nearby location close to the college campus. Students, faculty members, and staff gathered early in the morning, carrying saplings provided by the institution. The site was prepared in advance with designated plots for planting, and the participants enthusiastically planted a variety of trees, including fruit-bearing and shade-giving species. #### Objective:

- The celebration of International Yoga Day was organized to promote physical, mental, and spiritual well-being among students, faculty, and staff. The primary aim was to highlight the significance of yoga as an ancient practice that enhances holistic health and mindfulness. By conducting the program early in the morning, the event emphasized discipline, healthy lifestyle practices, and the importance of beginning the day with positivity and balance.

#### Activity Details:

- The event began at 6:00 AM, with participants assembling at the college ground in a calm and serene environment. The venue was arranged with yoga mats neatly placed in rows, and the space was decorated with banners displaying the theme of International Yoga Day and inspirational quotes on health and wellness. The instructor also explained the health benefits of each posture, emphasizing their role in improving concentration, reducing stress, and enhancing immunity.
- Throughout the session, participants were encouraged to focus on their breathing and maintain mindfulness, reinforcing yoga as a union of body and mind. Faculty members, staff, and students actively participated, making the event inclusive and community-driven. The calm discipline of the

participants created an inspiring atmosphere, demonstrating the collective spirit of adopting yoga as a lifestyle practice.

- After completing the yoga postures, the session concluded with guided relaxation techniques and chanting of “Om,” allowing everyone to end the practice on a peaceful note. A short talk was delivered by the principal, highlighting the relevance of yoga in today’s fast-paced lifestyle and encouraging students to adopt it as a daily habit.
- The event ended with refreshments being served, including herbal drinks and light snacks, reinforcing the message of healthy living. Many students shared their experiences, expressing how refreshing and energizing the early morning session felt

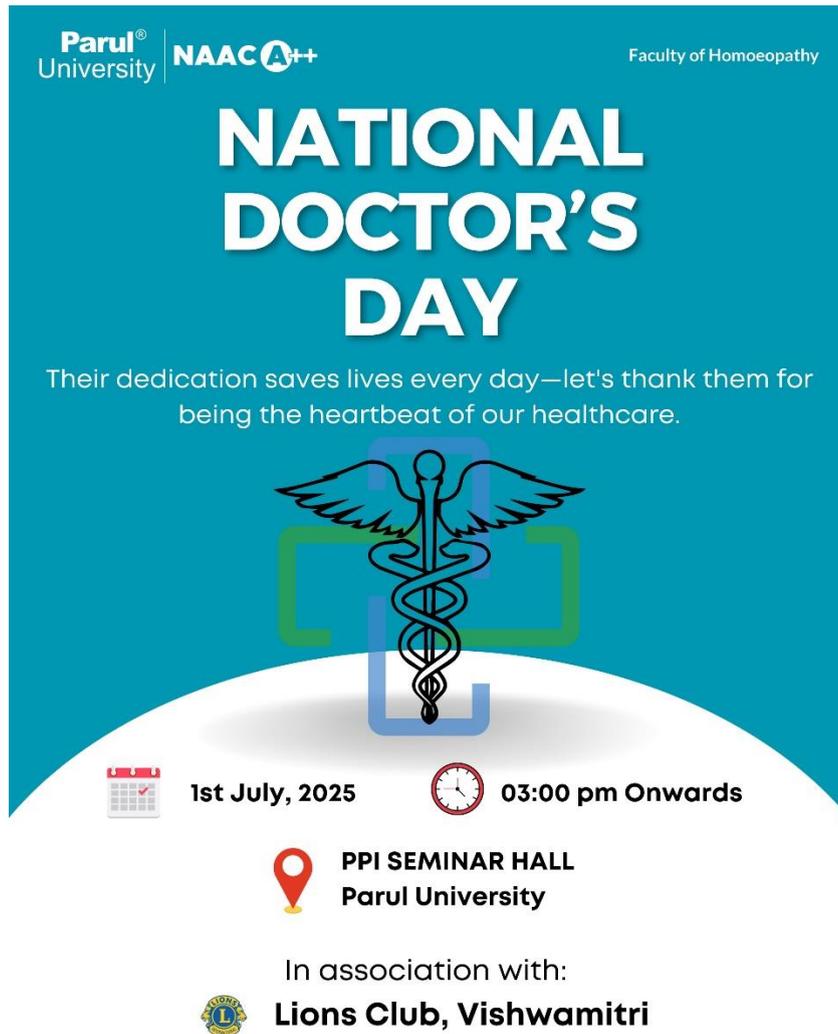

### Objective:

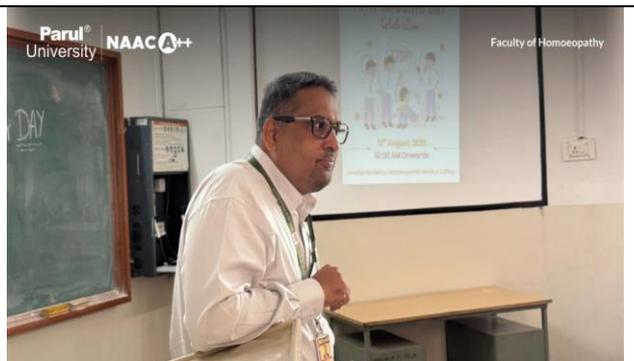

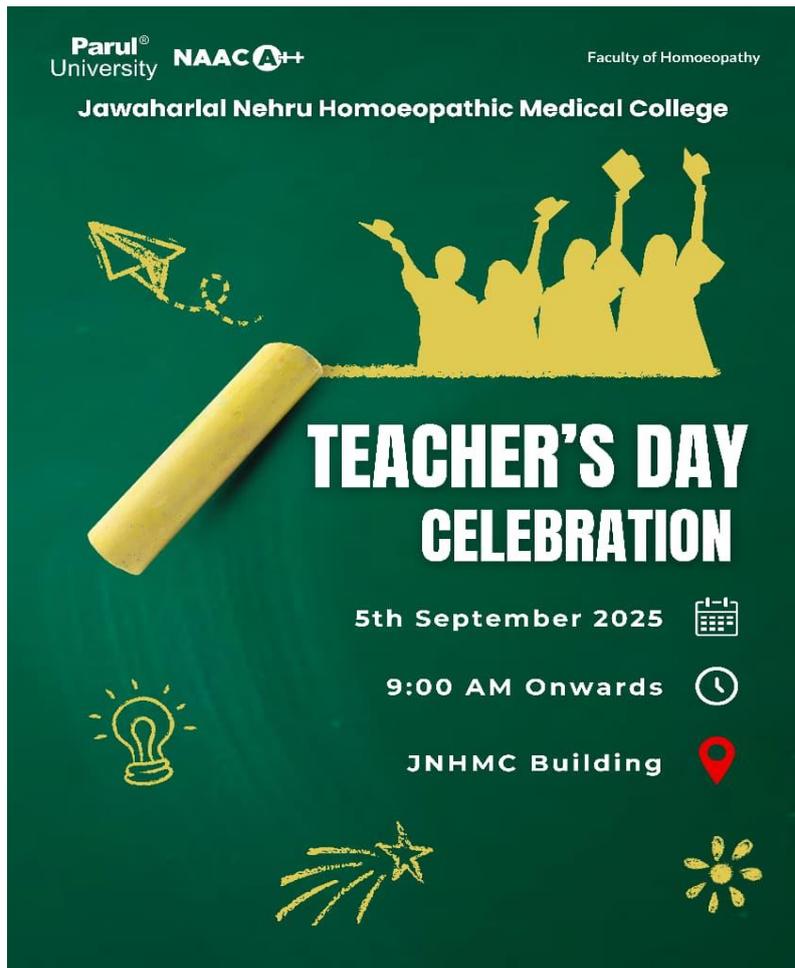

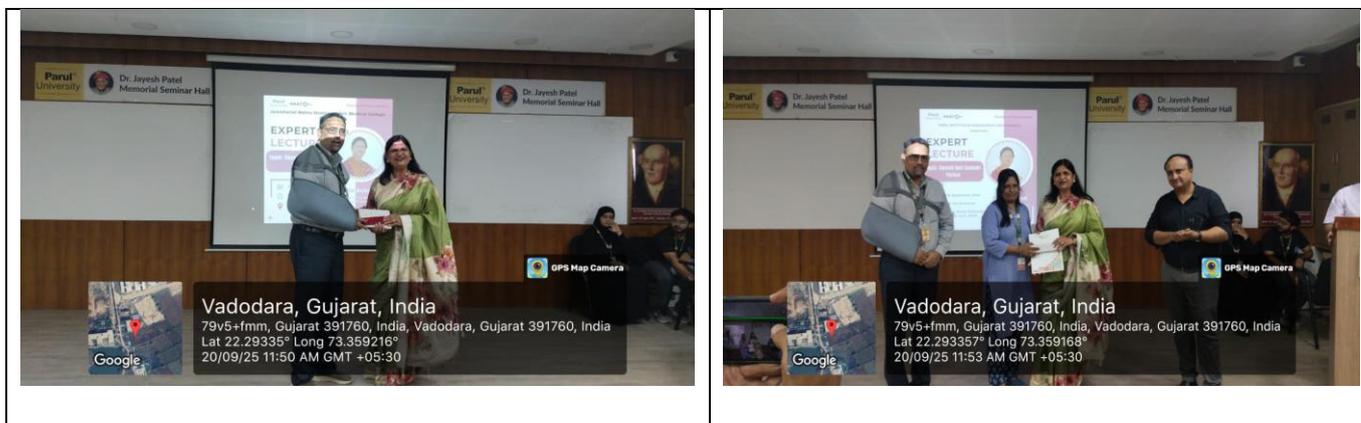
### Objective:

#### Day 2 – 29th November 2025

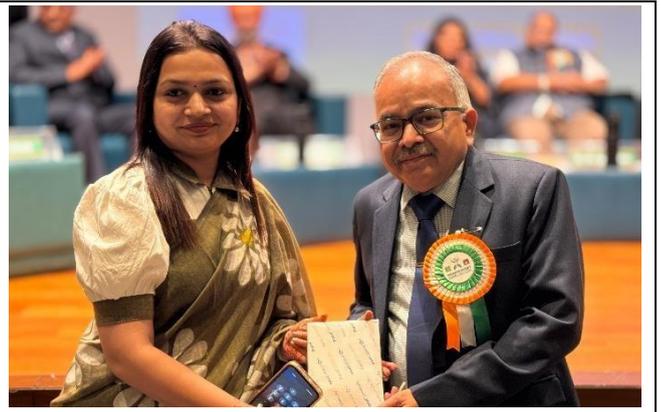
