REPORT- VISIT TO R.P.PATEL INSTITUTE OF HOMOEOPATHY

The institute is a three storey building which synchronises Dr. Hahnemann's birthplace at Meissen. Hahnemann's statue stands in the front garden, bust in the waiting hall & a portrait in the entrance wall reflects the love and affection towards Dr. Hahnemann.
