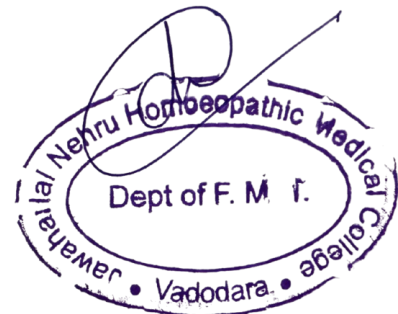

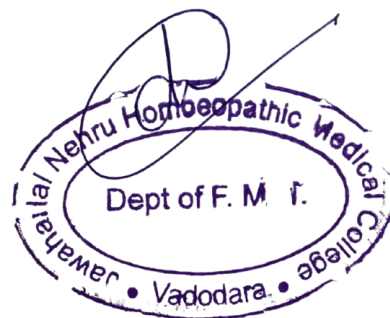

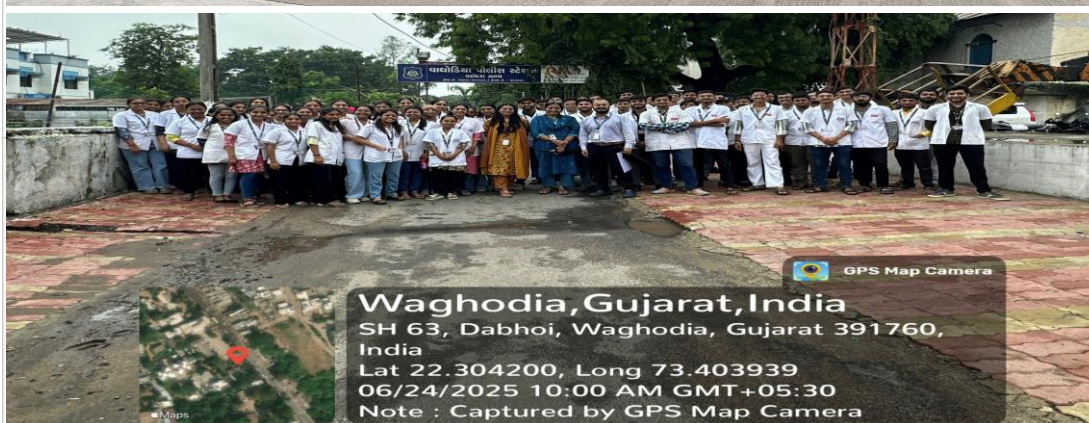
OBJECTIVES:

- To understand the medico-legal role of the police in healthcare-related investigations.
- To observe the procedures of registering FIRs, handling of medico-legal cases, and interaction with medical institutions.
- To enhance awareness about documentation requirements for doctors in legal cases (e.g., assault, rape, poisoning, death).
- To gain insight into the coordination between police and healthcare professionals in the justice system.
- To promote understanding of human rights, gender sensitivity, and ethical responsibilities in dealing with victims and accused.

OUTCOMES:

- Improved understanding of the legal framework surrounding forensic and emergency medical care.
- Ability to identify the steps involved in police procedures relevant to healthcare (e.g., MLC registration, inquest, dying declaration).
- Enhanced appreciation of the importance of accurate medical documentation and its legal value.
- Strengthened awareness of the doctor's responsibilities in reporting and assisting in medico-legal cases.
- Development of a practical outlook toward interdisciplinary collaboration between law enforcement and the medical profession.

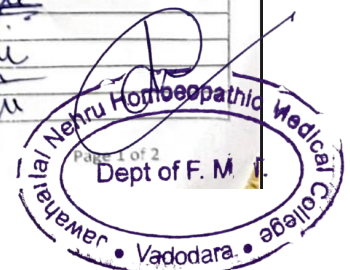

1. Purpose & Learning Objectives

The primary purpose of the visit was to provide students with practical exposure to **industrial-scale milk processing and pasteurisation techniques**. Specific learning objectives included:

- To understand the **process of pasteurisation** and its significance in ensuring milk safety.
- To gain insights into **quality control measures** adopted in the dairy industry.
- To study the **supply chain and distribution network** of a large dairy cooperative like Amul.
- To correlate **theoretical knowledge from classrooms** with industrial practices.
- To encourage awareness about **food safety standards, hygiene practices, and technological innovations** in the dairy sector.

2. Key Observations & Technical Learnings

- Students observed the **receiving and chilling of raw milk** at collection centers before processing.
- Detailed demonstration of the **pasteurization process** using the **HTST (High Temperature Short Time) method**, ensuring the destruction of pathogenic microorganisms.
- Exposure to **modern equipment** such as plate heat exchangers, homogenisers, and automatic packaging units.

- Importance of **temperature monitoring, quality testing, and hygiene protocols** was highlighted.
- Students learned about **by-products utilization** (butter, ghee, curd, cheese, etc.) and the value-added chain.
- Amul officials explained the **role of cooperative societies** in ensuring farmer welfare and sustainable dairy development.

3. Student Engagement (Q&A, Participation, Discipline)

- Students actively participated in **interactive sessions** with the technical staff of Amul.
- Several queries were raised about **pasteurization standards, packaging methods, and product safety**, showing enthusiasm and critical thinking.

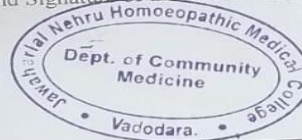

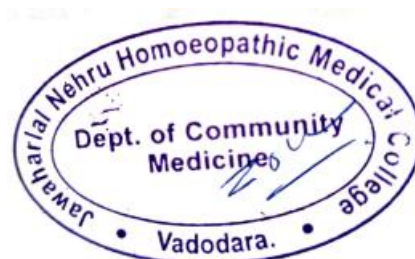

1. Purpose & Learning Objectives

The primary purpose of the field visit to the Primary Health Centre (PHC), Goraj, was to provide students with practical exposure to the functioning of a rural health facility and its role within the public health delivery system.

Learning Objectives:

- To understand the organisation and staffing pattern of a PHC.
- To study the range of healthcare services provided under National Health Programs.
- To observe patient flow, record-keeping, and referral mechanisms.
- To understand challenges in delivering primary healthcare in rural areas.
- To relate theoretical knowledge of community medicine with field realities.

2. Key Observations & Technical Learnings

- **Infrastructure:** The PHC had adequate infrastructure as per Indian Public Health Standards (IPHS), including OPD rooms, labour room, minor OT, and essential laboratory facilities.
- **Human Resources:** The team included a Medical Officer, Staff Nurse, Pharmacist, Lab Technician, and ANMs. ASHAs and Anganwadi workers were actively engaged in outreach services.

Services Provided:

- Outpatient services for minor ailments and maternal-child health.
- Immunization sessions under UIP.
- Family planning counseling and contraceptive distribution.

- Management of communicable and non-communicable diseases under NHM programs.
- Record Maintenance: Registers for MCH, immunization, disease surveillance, and drug inventory were well maintained and updated.
- Community Outreach: The PHC supervised several sub-centres and regularly conducted Village Health and Nutrition Days (VHNDs).
- Challenges Observed: Shortage of manpower and limited laboratory diagnostic facilities were noted.

Technical Learnings:

- Understanding of patient registration and reporting formats (HMIS).
- Observation of biomedical waste segregation and infection control practices.
- Exposure to supply chain management for essential drugs and vaccines.
- Practical understanding of referral linkages with the Community Health Center (CHC).

3. Student Engagement (Q&A, Participation, Discipline)

- Students actively interacted with the Medical Officer and nursing staff. They asked relevant questions on immunization logistics, disease surveillance, and data management.
- Participation during demonstrations in the labor room and OPD was enthusiastic.
- Overall discipline, punctuality, and attentiveness of students were commendable, reflecting sincere academic engagement.

4. SDGs Fulfilled

The visit contributed to understanding and promoting the following Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs):

- **SDG 3:** Good Health and Well-Being – by observing systems ensuring maternal, child, and general health services.
- **SDG 4:** Quality Education – through experiential learning in public health practice.
- **SDG 6:** Clean Water and Sanitation – through understanding of WASH and hygiene practices in healthcare settings.
- **SDG 17:** Partnerships for the Goals – by witnessing intersectoral coordination between health, ICDS, and community workers.

5. Industry Cooperation & Facilities Provided

- PHC staff extended full cooperation throughout the visit.
- Students were allowed to tour all service areas including OPD, IPD, laboratory, immunization room, and labor room.
- Demonstrations on vaccine storage, biomedical waste segregation, and patient record maintenance were provided.
- The PHC also facilitated access to health data and allowed interaction with community health workers.

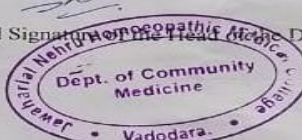

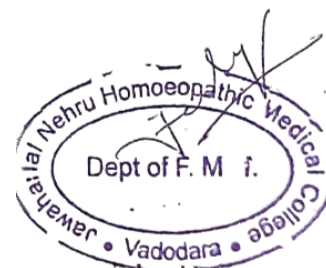

Purpose & Learning Objectives :

The educational visit to the District Court was organized to provide 2nd BHMS students with practical exposure to the judicial system and its interconnection with Forensic Medicine and Medico-Legal practice.

Objectives of the visit included:

To familiarise students with the structure and functioning of the District Court and its various divisions (Civil, Criminal, and Sessions).

To observe live court proceedings and understand the process of examination and cross-examination of witnesses, including medical experts.

To comprehend the legal importance of medical documentation such as postmortem reports, injury certificates, and medico-legal case (MLC) reports.

To understand the ethical and professional responsibilities of doctors serving as expert witnesses in the court of law.

To bridge theoretical knowledge of Forensic Medicine with real-world judicial applications.

Key Observations & Technical Learnings :

During the visit, students observed multiple sessions and proceedings across different courtrooms and gained valuable exposure to the judicial process.

Highlights and technical learnings included:

Court Functioning and Roles: Understanding the hierarchy and duties of judicial officers including Judges, Public Prosecutors, Defence Advocates, and Court Clerks.

Witness Testimonies: Observation of live witness examination, cross-examination, and the role of medical practitioners in delivering expert testimony.

Legal Documentation: Recognition of the critical role played by medical evidence—postmortem reports, injury certificates, and medical opinions—in influencing legal decisions.

Types of Cases: Exposure to cases involving bodily harm, poisoning, sexual offences, and accidents where medical evidence was central.

Professional Conduct: Learning courtroom discipline, communication etiquette, and the importance of precise, unbiased testimony by medical professionals.

Integration of Medicine & Law: Understanding how forensic medical findings assist the court in establishing facts and delivering justice.

Interactive Session with Judicial Officers :

After the court sessions, students had the valuable opportunity for face-to-face discussions with several Judges and legal officers.

Key insights gained included:

Understanding the expectations of the judiciary from medical experts during testimony.

Clarification on legal terminologies, medico-legal procedures, and how medical evidence supports the judicial decision-making process.

Discussion on ethical dilemmas faced by doctors in medico-legal situations.

Guidance on maintaining professional integrity, neutrality, and accuracy while preparing and presenting medico-legal documents.

Broader understanding of the collaboration between legal and medical systems in upholding justice and public welfare.

Students expressed great enthusiasm during the interaction, asking relevant questions related to practical medico-legal issues, documentation, and expert witness responsibilities. The judges appreciated the students' curiosity and highlighted the vital role of doctors in the justice delivery system.

Student Engagement:

The 2nd BHMS students demonstrated active participation, discipline, and professionalism throughout the visit.

Engagement Outcomes:

Maintained respectful behavior and attentiveness during courtroom sessions.

Participated in Q&A sessions and discussions with legal professionals and faculty.


Took detailed notes of observations and clarified medico-legal concepts post-visit.

Reflected on the visit through interactive debriefing sessions in the department

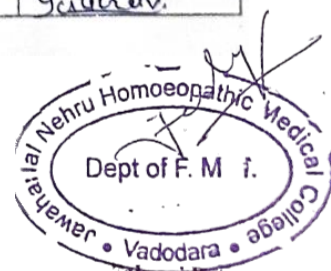

1. Purpose & Learning Objectives

- To provide students with first-hand exposure to the operational aspects of a Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) and its role in environmental sanitation and public health protection.
- To help students understand the complete sewage treatment process, from inlet screening to final effluent discharge or reuse.
- To correlate theoretical knowledge of wastewater management with real-world infrastructure and practices.
- To sensitise students to the public health importance of safe sewage disposal in preventing waterborne diseases and environmental pollution.
- To introduce students to occupational health and safety measures followed by STP personnel.

2. Key Observations & Technical Learnings

Students observed the major components of the STP, including:

- Inlet chamber and bar screens
- Grit chamber
- Primary sedimentation tank
- Aeration tank (biological treatment)
- Secondary clarifier
- Sludge drying beds/sludge management unit
- Understanding of primary, secondary, and tertiary treatment processes was reinforced through on-site explanation.

- Students learned about:
- Removal of suspended solids, organic matter, and pathogens
- Role of microorganisms in biological treatment
- Importance of maintaining parameters such as BOD, COD, and dissolved oxygen
- Observation of treated effluent quality and its reuse for gardening, irrigation, or safe discharge as per regulatory norms.
- Awareness was created regarding environmental regulations and pollution control standards related to wastewater management.

3. Student Engagement (Q&A, Participation, Discipline)

Students actively participated by:

- Asking questions regarding treatment efficiency, capacity, and maintenance challenges
- Clarifying doubts related to odour control, sludge disposal, and health hazards
- High level of discipline and attentiveness was maintained throughout the visit.
- Students followed safety instructions and remained in designated areas during the plant tour.
- Interactive discussion sessions helped students link public health concepts with environmental engineering practices.
- Overall engagement indicated keen interest and curiosity, enhancing experiential learning.

The field visit contributed towards understanding and promoting the following Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs):

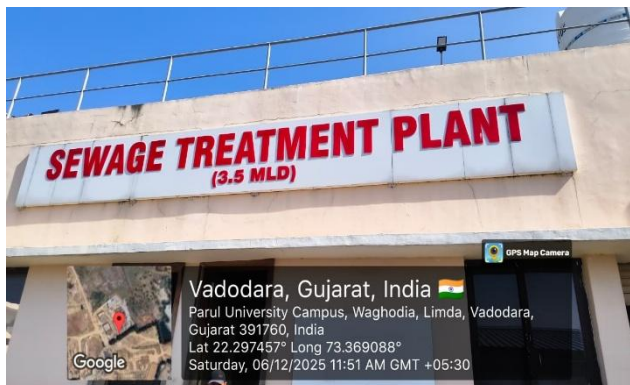

EDUCATIONAL FIELD VISIT TO WATER PURIFICATION PLANT

Date: 19/12/2025

1. Purpose & Learning Objectives

The field visit to the Water Purification Plant was organized to provide students with practical exposure to the processes involved in the treatment and supply of safe drinking water. The visit aimed to bridge the gap between theoretical knowledge taught in the classroom and real-world public health practices.

The specific learning objectives were:

- To understand the complete process of water purification from raw water intake to final distribution.
- To familiarise students with various physical, chemical, and biological treatment methods used to ensure potable water quality.
- To highlight the importance of safe drinking water in the prevention of water-borne diseases.
- To sensitise students to the role of water purification plants in community health and environmental sustainability.

2. Key Observations & Technical Learnings

Students observed the sequential stages of water treatment, starting from raw water collection from surface sources. The technical processes demonstrated included:

- Screening and Aeration: Removal of large debris and improvement of water quality by increasing dissolved oxygen.
- Coagulation and Flocculation: Use of coagulants (such as alum) to aggregate suspended particles.
- Sedimentation: Settling of flocs to reduce turbidity.
- Filtration: Passing water through sand and gravel filters to remove remaining impurities.

- Disinfection: Chlorination and other disinfection methods to eliminate pathogenic microorganisms.
- Storage and Distribution: Ensuring treated water is safely stored and supplied to the community.

3. Student Engagement (Q&A, Participation, Discipline)

Students actively participated throughout the visit and demonstrated keen interest in the functioning of the plant. They engaged in interactive question-and-answer sessions with plant officials, seeking clarification on treatment efficiency, challenges faced during monsoon seasons, and emergency response during contamination events.

The students maintained proper discipline, followed safety instructions, and listened attentively during technical explanations. Their participation reflected a high level of academic curiosity and professionalism.

4. SDGs Fulfilled

The field visit contributed to the understanding and promotion of several Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs):

- SDG 3: Good Health and Well-being – Emphasising the role of safe drinking water in disease prevention.
- SDG 6: Clean Water and Sanitation – Understanding sustainable management of water resources and access to safe water.
- SDG 4: Quality Education – Enhancing experiential learning through field-based education.
- SDG 13: Climate Action – Awareness about sustainable water management and environmental protection.

5. Industry Cooperation & Facilities Provided

The management and technical staff of the Water Purification Plant extended full cooperation during the visit. They provided detailed explanations of each treatment unit, demonstrated operational procedures, and shared practical insights into plant management and maintenance. Facilities such as guided tours, technical demonstrations, and access to operational areas were made available to the students. The cooperation of the industry personnel significantly enhanced the learning experience and ensured the visit was informative, safe, and well-organised.
