

DETAILS OF THE RESEARCH WORK PERFORMED

(Give full details)

1. What were the aims and objectives of the Project: Clinically ascertaining the efficacy of Homoeopathic treatment in acute upper respiratory tract infection.
To understand the serum C - reactive protein level in accordance with clinical recovery from Acute Upper Respiratory Tract Infection in Homeopathic treatment
2. Describe the research work performed:
Single blind prospective clinical interventional study, in which patients were enrolled from O.P.D. as and when they come, after confirmation of their inclusion criteria as per protocol, till such time that the target is achieved. The Homoeopathic medicines was prescribed to patients diagnosed for Acute Respiratory tract infection as per the Homoeopathic guidelines. Patient's follow up was carried out on 5th day or as per requirement. Laboratory investigation for CBC, CRP done at start of treatment and on 5th day of illness. Outcome of treatment was assessed through a self-designed questionnaire and investigations.
3. Describe the results obtained:
The study results revealed a significant improvement in symptoms score ($P = 0.000$, 5% level) and reduction in serum C – reactive protein level ($P = 0.008$, 5% level) after treatment. Results also inferred that treatment helped patients to abolish impact of illness on usual activity ($P = 0.000$, 5% significant level) and recover from status of illness ($P = 0.000$, 5% significant level).
