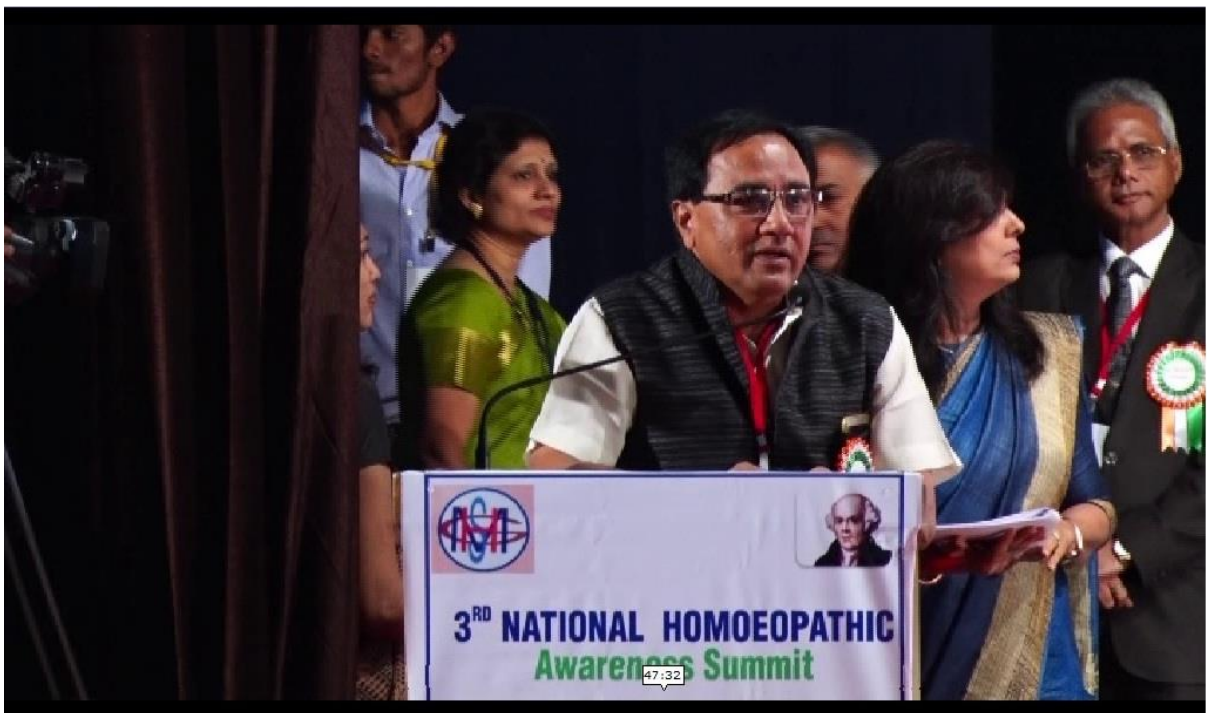

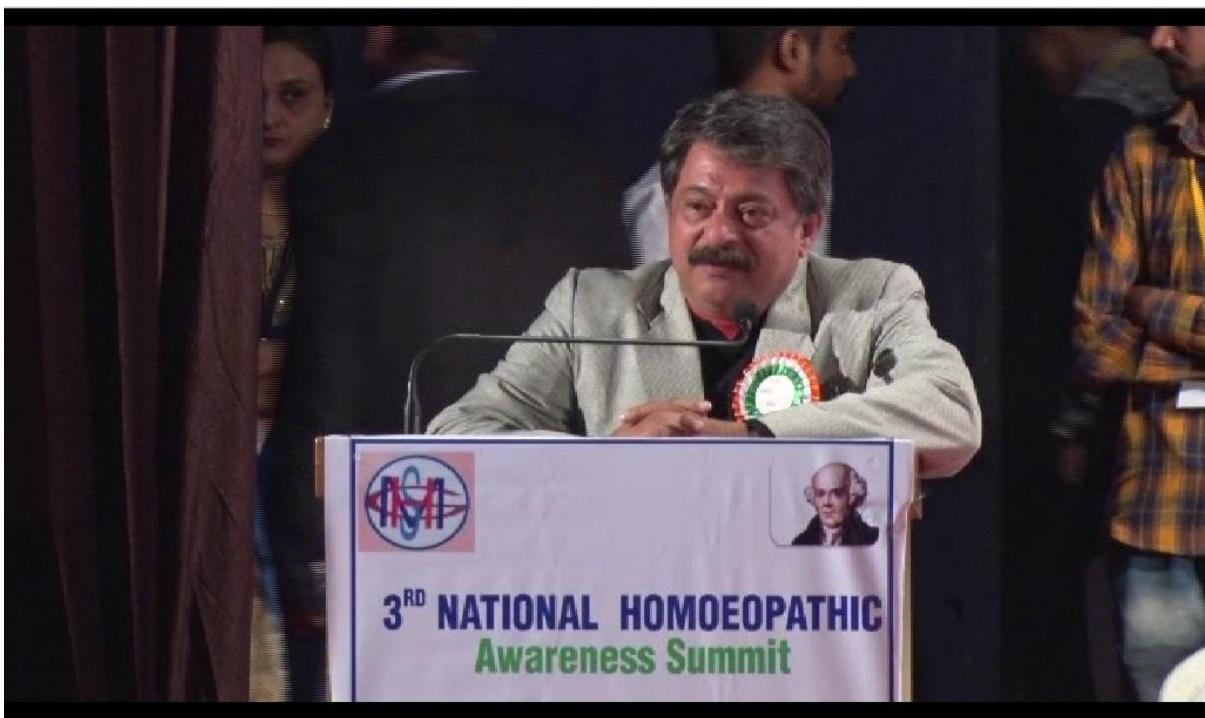

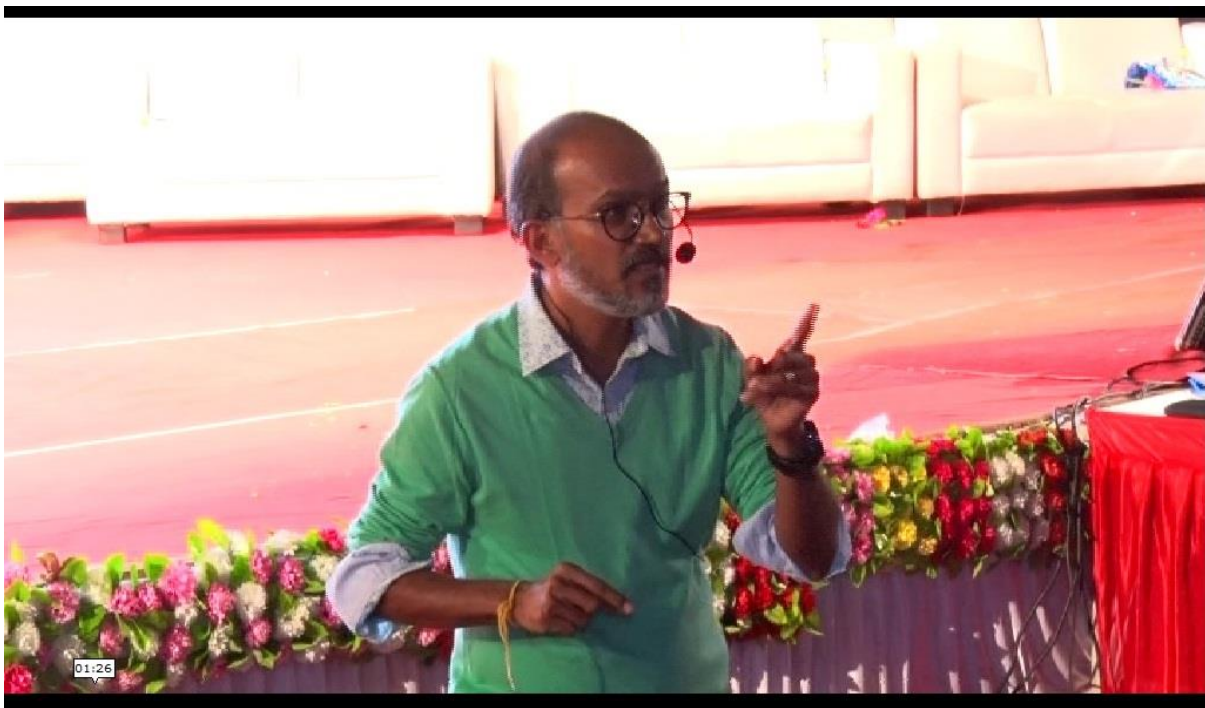
“Lifetime Achievement Award.”

Then the most awaited moment of the day came when the chief guest **Mr. Rajendrabhai Trivedi** delivered his speech. The very enthusiastic & energetic Rajendrabhai delivered his speech in Gujarati language. He spoke about state council, medical fraternity, homoeopathic fraternity, education system, his department of sports & culture & left no stone unturned. In his speech of about 45 minutes he has shared his own experiences with homoeopathy and didn't forget to mention the names of great homoeopaths Dr. Habboo from Pune & Dr. Sankaran from Mumbai & Dr. Kantibhai seth famously known as Kantikaka from Gujarat.



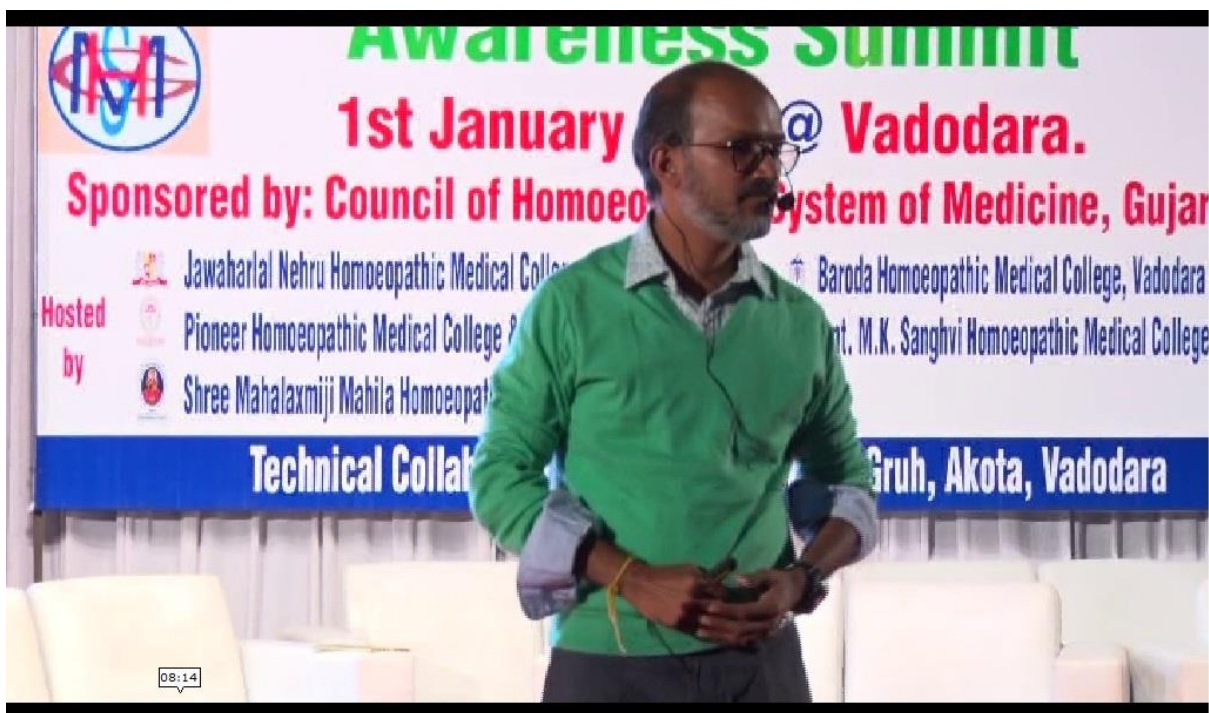
He has also stated about west Bengal being the hub of Homoeopathy in India. He has also motivated & inspired the students for their studies & doing hard work during their course. He stated that

whatever you are going to do is a divine work, it's a god's work & you are amongst the lucky ones who are chosen to do this. You have not entered in this field but you are brought in this field & brought by none other than almighty god. Many of the students try to come to this field but very few get selected even I tried it for three successive years but I failed, I could not make it; you are the lucky ones so take complete advantage of this and do your best. At the end of his speech he has assured the students to come to him for any kind of help they need. He and his department will be pleased to help them out. The students gave him a huge round of applaud & a standing ovation too. The speech was followed by the second most awaited moment of the day when the speaker **Dr. Dinesh Chauhan** started his lecture. The very wise though humble, the very intelligent though soft spoken & down to earth personality Dr. Chauhan started his first session with a simple question "what are your doubts and objections about homoeopathy?" for which many answers came out from students. So it was an interactive session in deed. Then he told about his own frustrations with homoeopathy in his initial days of study & practice, his unfulfilled wish to be a neurologist & an allopathic physician; later on enlightenment from his mentor & teacher, and a great support by his sister he got back to homoeopathy.



Then he discussed about his struggles & efforts with learning & practicing homoeopathy, finally how he understood homoeopathy.

In his first session he mentioned about the theoretical part of homoeopathy and in his second session he explained about the practical part of it. He has explained about miasms, evolution of miasms, individualisation, and individualisation at a whole level, PQRS symptoms, classical & integrated methods of homoeopathy, various methods used since Dr. Dhawale's time till this time. He has also explained about his ideas about case taking, the most integral & important part of homoeopathy. What he thinks about case taking an integrative, simple, scientific, reproducible 3 step procedure which are inactive, active & active/ active. The first theoretical session was followed by a lunch break. The students enjoyed delicious lunch served to them.



Post lunch session contained his practical part, where he explained about various cases including some difficult & incurable cases. He has also given audio visual presentations of his cases. How he took these cases & how he reached to similimum. How he prescribed & selected potencies what were the miraculous outcomes with homoeopathy.

The students really enjoyed this session and asked many questions to him. Dr.Chauhan cleared all their doubts.



After explaining about 4-5 cases in detail he beaded good bye to students at 5 pm in evening & promised to come back when ever called. The students enjoyed tea & snack with him and started getting back to their respective destinations.
