At 3:35 PM, **Dr. Riya Jodha** introduced the judges and dignitaries, acknowledging their contribution to mental health awareness.

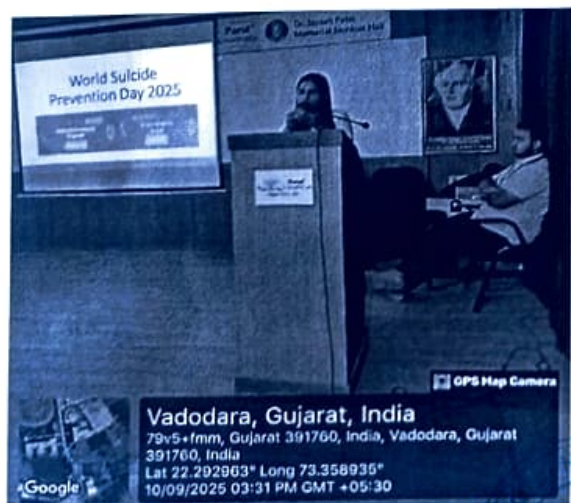
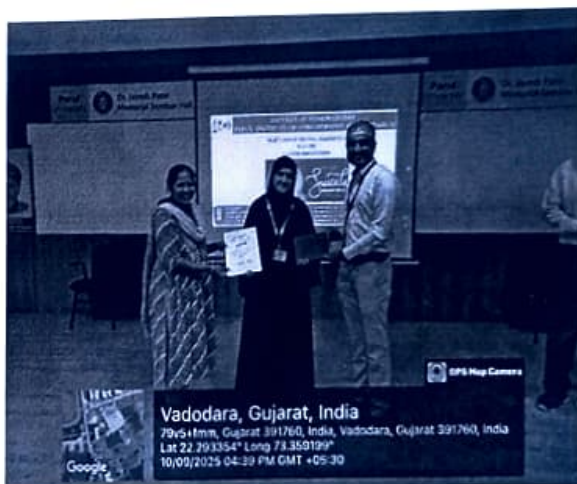
