Outcome: 1. Enhanced Understanding

- Participants gained a deeper insight into the philosophical and scientific basis of homoeopathy.
- Clarified the differences and complementary roles of homoeopathy and allopathy in treating various conditions.

2. Opportunities Identified

- Integration in primary care for lifestyle and chronic diseases.
- Use of homoeopathy as a preventive approach or in supportive therapy, especially for non-communicable diseases (NCDs), paediatrics, and geriatrics.
- Potential to reduce healthcare costs and drug dependency in certain cases.

3. Challenges Highlighted

- Lack of standardization and scientific validation remains a key barrier.
- Need for evidence-based practices and more clinical trials.
- Regulatory and policy-related challenges for broader acceptance in modern healthcare.
- Skepticism among medical professionals due to limited mechanistic understanding.

4. Strategic Suggestions

- Promote interdisciplinary research to build a solid evidence base.
- Develop integrated treatment protocols combining strengths of different systems.
- Encourage policy-level support for integrated healthcare models.
- Increase collaboration between homoeopaths and allopaths through CME programs, seminars, and joint clinics.

5. Action Points / Recommendations

- Establish integrative healthcare centers where patients can access both systems.
- Initiate public awareness campaigns about the scope and limitations of homoeopathy.
- Encourage institutions to include modules on integrative medicine in medical curricula.

6. Networking & Collaboration

- The talk served as a platform for experts, practitioners, and policymakers to exchange ideas and consider collaborative projects.
- Opportunities for future research and joint publications were explored.
