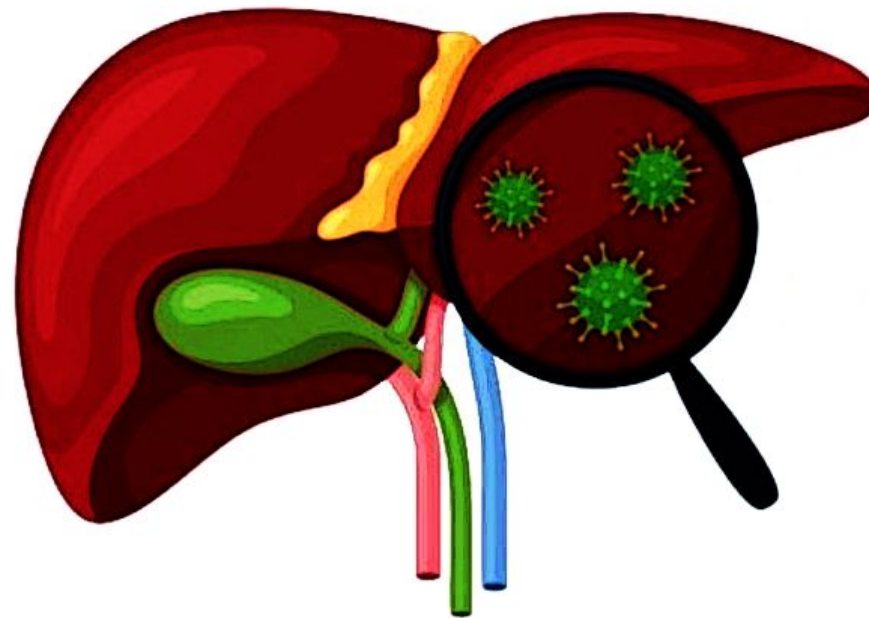

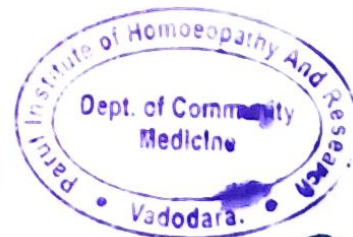

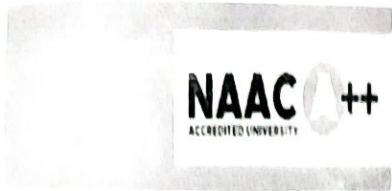

To raise awareness about hepatitis, including the infectious diseases hepatitis A, B, C, D, and E.

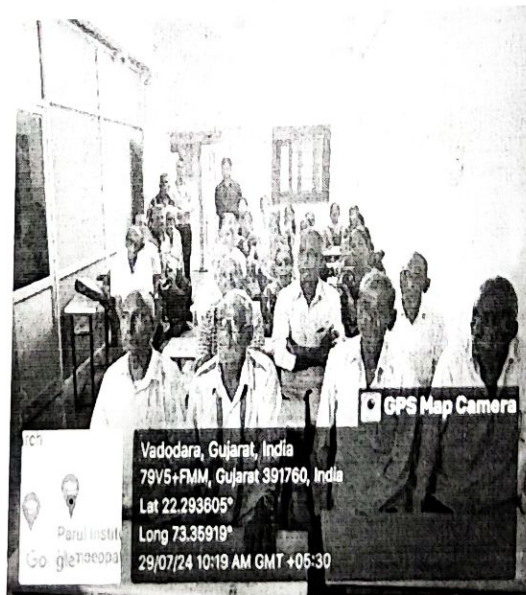
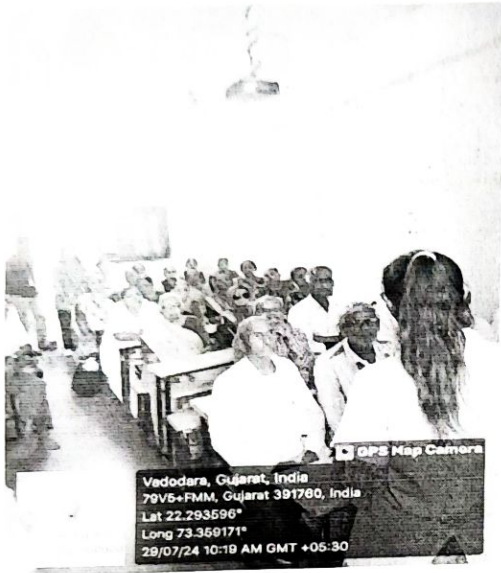
Outcome

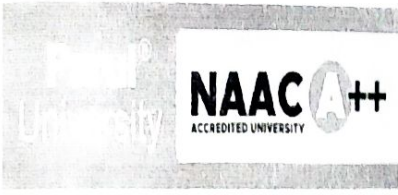
