Following which the students were taken to the lodge Gurukrupa arranged by World healing society foundation. They were then taken for lunch.

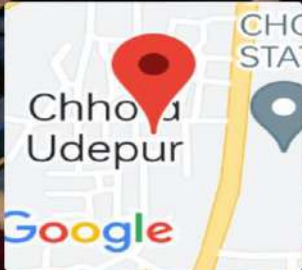

The NSS unit of Parul University had also performed to demonstrate the importance the health workers (safaikarmachari) in our country for the common public.

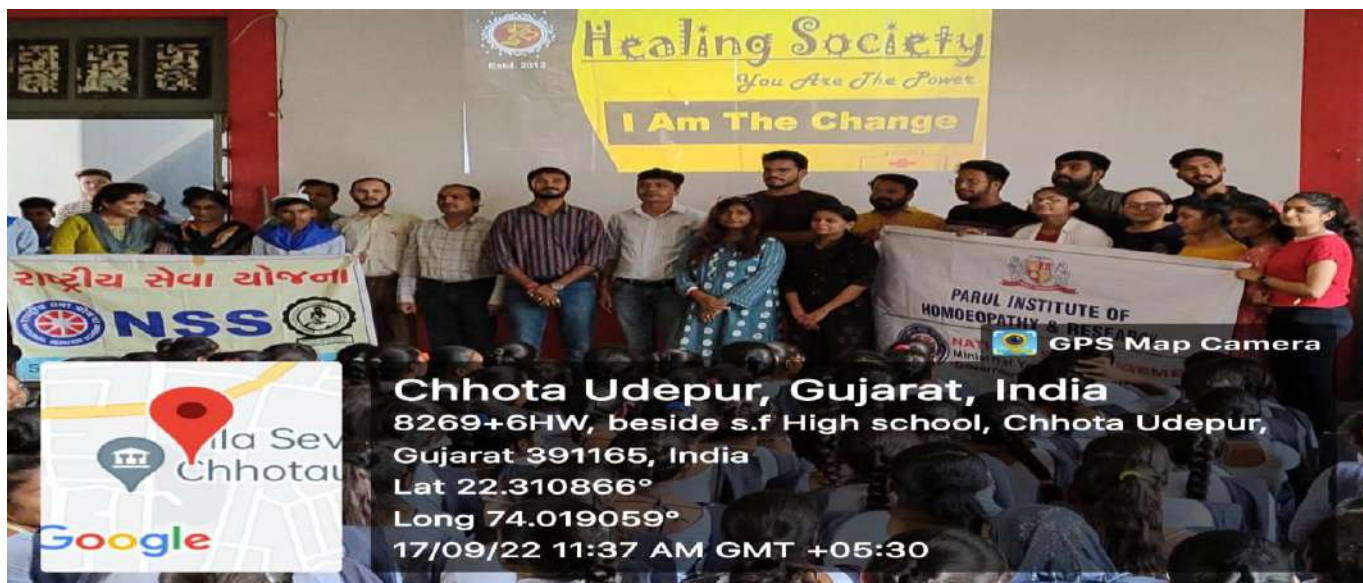




Activity 2

Activity 3

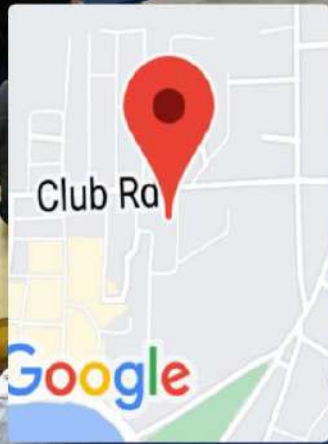

Students were taken to the Bhasha Van - Adivasi Academy for a visit to understand the heritage of the Indian tribal community, its culture and the importance of tribal language.

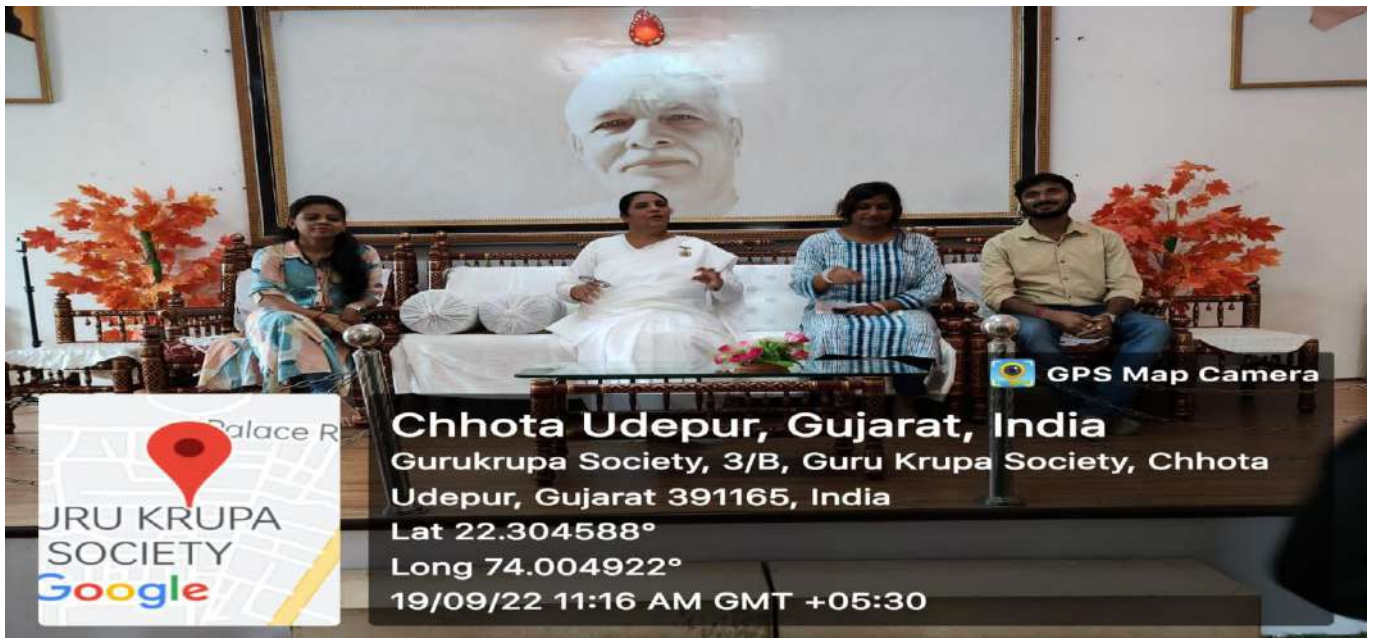


DAY: 6
