World TB Day is celebrated each year on March 24 to raise public awareness about the disease and its consequences on health, social and economic aspects. Efforts are also taken to reduce the global tuberculosis burden. Despite significant rise in awareness and good health care facilities TB prevalence continues to be present in India. Multidrug-resistant TB (MDR-TB) poses a grave public health threat especially in high HIV prevalence settings.

The Department of Community Medicine on this occasion had organized a special awareness session for hospital patients. Dr Pankaj Shah, Medical Officer for in PIHR Hospital was the speaker for this event. Dr. Pankaj Shah addressed the patients on the Epidemiology of Tuberculosis, symptomatology, investigations and treatment plan for TB and elaborated the National Tuberculosis Elimination Programme, its aim & objectives . He also explained the necessity of maintaining personal hygiene and preventive measures to stop the spread of disease.
