Also, we saw pictures of few of medical instruments used by him like stethoscope, weighting machine, porcelain mortar and pestle etc. Then we saw photos of medical instruments & Hahnemann's family members. We saw image of Hahnemann's death bed. We also got some information about card repertory by Gopal Patel. How it can be used. and also, method of repertorisation from card repertory.

We also saw some charts related to principles, literature of homoeopathy and contribution of different pioneers. We also saw the plenty of book which was written by Dr. J. T Kent. wall of fam of Kent's life showed us his gratitude and his dedication towards the field of homoeopathy.

Then we had exclusive demonstration on auto- visual repertory by Dr. Arun Patel. Then we visit the clinic, record keeping room where we explained about importance of record keeping. Following, we saw the dispensary where Dr. Arun Patel sir taught us preparation and use of 50 millesimal scale. Then we had short interactive session with sir where we solve many of our doubts.
