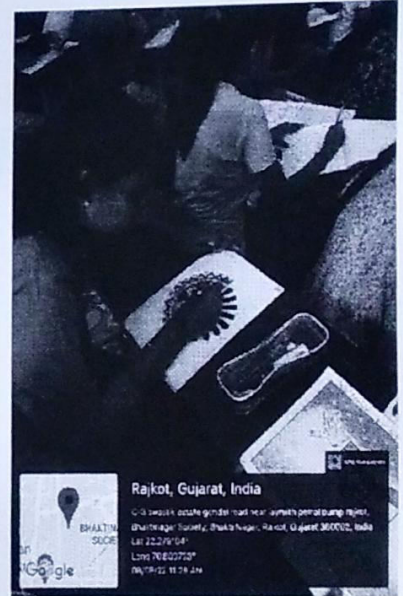
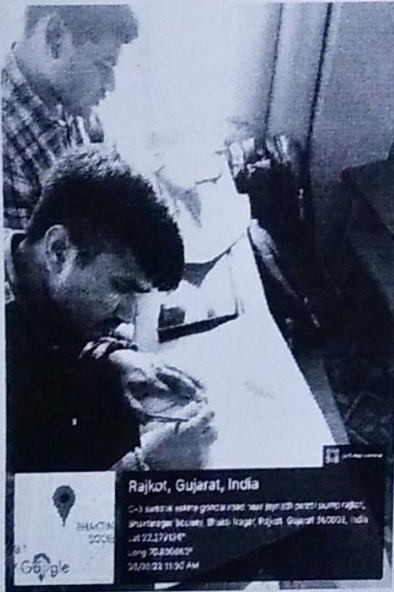


ABOUT THE HAR GHAR TIRANGA CAMPAIGN
