Sub:- Permission matter of Rajkot Homoeopathic Medical College, Jainath Petrol Pump, Gondal Road, Rajkot-360 002, with 100 seats in UG (BHMS) course for the academic session 2021-22-reg.

Sir,

As Central Government by notification, constituted the National Commission for Homoeopathy, to exercise the powers conferred upon, and to perform the functions assigned to it, under NCH Act 2020. As per section 59 (2) of NCH Act, 2020, following has been stated:

“Notwithstanding the repeal of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act 1973, the educational and medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and the rules and regulations made thereunder shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made thereunder: Provided that anything done or any action taken as regards the educational and medical standards and requirements under the enactment under repeal and the rules and regulations made thereunder shall be deemed to have been done or taken under the corresponding provision of this Act and shall continue in force accordingly unless and until superseded by anything or by any action taken under this Act”.

As per provision in the Act, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy has been constituted with the mandate to grant permission to the existing and new medical institution of Homoeopathy. Accordingly, it is to inform you that all the relevant documents submitted by your college in Part-1 proforma were examined by the the Medical Assessment and Rating Board and it has been decided to recommend for approval of permission to the College and Hospital for the academic year 2021-22.

2. On careful consideration of the report, the Medical Assesment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy has arrived at the following conclusions:-

- I. That the applicant fulfills the eligibility criteria
- II. That the applicant has set up the Homoeopathic College and Teaching Hospital with the component of staff, infrastructure, equipment and instruments and other facilities in terms of minimum standards requirements of homoeopathic colleges and attached hospitals as prescribed by the Council for running Under Graduate courses in Homoeopathy.

3. After considering the provisions of section 12C (1) of Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and HCC(MSR) Regulations, 2013, as amended in 2018, permission of the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy is hereby accorded to Rajkot Homoeopathic Medical College, Jainath Petrol Pump, Gondal Road, Rajkot-360 002, with 100 seats in UG (BHMS) course for the academic session 2021-22.

4. It is further informed that, minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of BHMS course shall be treated as All India quota. The counseling for seats under All India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling Authority of State / UT Government as designated by the Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling Authority of that State / UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government for All India quota or the student admitted thereunder.


5. All admissions in undergraduate courses shall be through NEET and the list of candidates selected category wise may be informed to the National Commission for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET qualified students will not be approved by the Board as per rules and penalty as decided by Commission will be imposed.

6. The college has to comply with the full requirements of HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013 and as amended from time to time for conducting the course. Compliance report shall be submitted by the college to Medical Assessment and Rating Board/National Commission for Homoeopathy after starting of UG/PG course, before 31st December, 2021.

7. Board may take up inspection anytime during the academic year and if deficiencies are not addressed within 3 months positively from the date of issue of this letter and attached letter, and permission for the next academic year (2022-23) shall not be considered, even if complied after 3 months.
