However, the student's attitude has seemingly not improved over this period and seems to be deteriorating. In view of same, request you to take suitable action in the interests of female students and faculties of FMS and in the interest of this student for required medication and rehabilitation.

Sub: - Recommendations of Inquiry and cum Disciplinary Committee to inquire into the complaint filed by Dean, Faculty of Management Studies against indisciplined acts of a student by name Urveesh Solankee

Ref: (i) No.R/Office Order-981/2022-23 dated 27.1.2023

(ii) Approval of the Provost

Based on the complaint filed by female teachers regarding instances of mental harassment caused to them by inappropriate conduct of a first semester student of MBA programme by name Urveesh Solankee, Enrollment Number: 2206172000896, the university had constituted Inquiry and cum Disciplinary Committee to conduct an inquiry and submit its recommendations to the university.

The Inquiry Committee met on 1.2.2023 and called female teachers who had filed the complaint along with the concerned student and his parents. The members of Inquiry Committee also invited Dr.Dipal Patel, Psychologist and Mental Health Expert in the university to remain present during the inquiry.

Upon inquiring into the issue, the members of Inquiry Committee felt that the concerned student required counseling. Hence, the concerned student along with his parents was sent to Shri.Arshad Aman, Student Counsellor for counselling.

Student Counsellor opined that Urveesh Solankee appears to be suffering from traumatic issue which can be cured with medicinal treatment. He advised the parents of the student to keep the student with them for one month and seek help of mental health professional.

The Inquiry Committee has recommended that the said student should be informed to remain on leave for a period of one month in order to seek help of mental health professional.

After a period of one month, after the said student has joined, the Inquiry Committee, will meet again and decide on the further course of action in case the concerned student continues behaving in an inappropriate manner.

- Enquiry on the matter was initially done and the student was found guilty, with certain psychiatric and traumatic issues since his childhood.
- The student was advised for further medications and psychiatric counselling for certain period of time.
- The student can attend his lectures only after further enquiry about mental well being, post medications and treatment.
- Framing of Internal Committee from respective institutions for smooth conduct of the activities is required for the better handling of issues related to health and well being at work place.


