

Book Publications



Faculty of Ayurveda organised Many competitions in the month of December and January which have helped the students to grow and develop their skills.










Cervical Awareness Month

A male patient aged 32 years from Mumbai, complaining of difficulty in sitting, standing and talking since 4 months; swelling of lower limbs and stiffness all over the body since 4 months. He had a past history of Drug induced Parkinsonism before 4 months, came to Panchakarma OPD of Parul Ayurved Hospital. He was treated with 7 days course of





Udvartana, Baspa Sweda, Sodhana Nasya and Nitya Virechana. After that he was treated with Utsadana, swedana, and Samana Nasya for a period of 10 days. At the time of discharge patient was able to sit and stand properly. He was able to walk by his own and able to respond our commands verbally. There was also a significant reduction in swelling and stiffness all over the body. And patient lost around 4 kg of body weight during the course of treatment.
