The total marks for evaluation of 2 <sup>nd</sup> BAMS will be 1250.
3	3 <sup>rd</sup> BAMS For subject Charaka Samhita (Uttarardh) there was no weightage for practical. The total marks for evaluation of 3 <sup>rd</sup> BAMS will be 1000.	3 <sup>rd</sup> BAMS 50 marks weightage is included. Thus, the subject will be evaluated for a total of 150 marks. The total marks for evaluation of 3 <sup>rd</sup> BAMS will be 1050.
